- ◆ To serve as “Vestry Person of the Day” on a rotating basis for our weekend worship services.

Qualifications:

“Any confirmed communicant in good standing of the Parish who is not less than eighteen years of age, and a regular communicant upon the services in the year preceding election, and known by the Treasurer to have made and maintained a stated financial commitment for church support in the year preceding election.”
